Menaal was born with Thalassemia Major, a lifelong blood condition, only curable via a bone marrow transplant (BMT). From the age of just 6 weeks old, she depended on blood transfusions, every 3-5 weeks. At the age of 17, she underwent a BMT to cure her of Thalassemia, but unfortunately, due to complications, she passed away less than a month after her 18th birthday.


During her short but beautiful life,
Menaal received around 270 blood
transfusions. These regular transfusions
helped Menaal live her life to the fullest,
safe in the knowledge that the next blood
transfusion would keep her feeling well.
Furthermore, during the 2.5 months that
she was in the hospital for her BMT
through to her untimely passing, she not
only depended on the blood transfusions
as she had always done, but also needed
platelets and plasma too - sometimes
daily.
